

## **2017 Show Theme Explanation – Two-Color Quilt**

The quilt must be of only two colors; i.e. red and white, or teal and brown. Each color may be represented by a single fabric or many fabrics, however, you must stick with only your selected two colors. You may use all values of your two colors. Example.... Reds may range from pink to dark red and count as one of your colors. The quilt may be any size and use any technique (pieced, applique, paper pieced).

A combination of two colors with a neutral is three colors and would not be accepted in our Theme category, but perfectly acceptable in another category. If using beige as a neutral, it would be counted as one color and you could use a range of beige colors in your quilt with only one other color. White would not be in the beige range. It would become an additional color. If your quilt does not qualify for the Two-Color Theme category, we are sure you can find a different category to enter that quilt in the 2017 Three Rivers Quilt Show.
