If your quilt is entered in the show you just need to call to arrange payment and Jan will appraise your quilt before she leaves on Thursday.

Why have your quilt appraised? An appraisal is needed to insure your quilt and is required to claim insurance if your quilt is lost in the mail. Many people don't know but you can probably add that quilt to your Homeowner's Policy under a Fine Arts rider and get coverage for a full year for less than insuring it via your postal option. It doesn't hurt to make that phone call and compare if you are mailing a quilt.

An appraisal accompanying a quilt presented as a gift may make the recipient aware the quilt has more than "sentimental" value.
