Miniature	One	<24" per side	Any technique but on a small scale. Quilts using traditional patterns—a scaled down version of a larger quilt— should include blocks no larger than 4 in" square. A hanging sleeve is helpful, but not required.
Mixed Technique	Any	Any size Max. width 100"	Balanced combination of both appliqué and piecing; including embroidery & other needlework techniques in any combination.
Modern	Any	Any size Max. width 100"	Functional rather than decorative design, asymmetric design, increased negative space, improvisational piecing, modern art/architectural inspired design, simplistic and/ or minimalist.
Potpourri	Any	Any size Max. width 100"	Crazy Quilt, Yo-Yo, Cathedral Windows or Wholecloth (no tied quilts will be accepted).

General Rules	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Limit of three (3) quilts per entrant. If entering more than 1 quilt, indicate your priority for consideration: 1, 2, or 3. Priority will be considered when the number of qualified entries is excessive and must be limited. All entries accepted will be judged. All entries must be quilted. A quilted entry consists of three (3) layers, primarily fabric, held together by stitching. Quilting stitches pierce all three (3) layers and are distributed throughout the entry. EXCEPT for those placed in the Potpourri category (if offered). No tied quilts will be accepted. NO WEIGHTS OF ANY KIND SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE QUILT. All entries must have been completed within the last five (5) years. Please do not submit entries completed before January 1, 2012. All entries must be clean, smoke free, labeled, and ready to hang. Detailed instructions will be included in the jury acceptance letter. No items entered and shown in previous Three Rivers Quilt Shows should be submitted. <p>► I agree to abide by the rules as stated above: (sign)</p>
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➔ **Each entrant must submit: Please check to make sure your entry includes ALL of the following.**

- One **completed**, signed entry form for each entry.
- (2) color 4" x 6" photos (non-returnable) for each entry (**Full front view & Close-up** of front stitching). Nothing larger than 4x6 please!
- **ENTRY FEE: \$13.00 for 1st entry, \$10 each additional entry (ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETE WITH PHOTOS).**
- Members of Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. get their first entry for a \$1 handling fee, \$10 for each additional entry.
- Make checks out to "Three Rivers Quilters, Inc." (No cash, *exception for TRQ members' \$1 entry*).
- **OPTIONAL SUBMISSION:** Scanned entry form and digital photos accepted – *no faxes*. Email completed documents to registrar below. Entry fees must be promptly mailed to address below. Please add additional **\$1 per entry** for processing/printing digital photo submission.

Security will be provided 24 hours a day during the show by the Meadows Racetrack & Casino.

Insurance during the show will be provided by Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. in the following amounts: \$500 for quilts greater than 48" on the shortest side; \$100 for quilts shorter than 48" on the shortest side. **Be sure to include your quilt on your homeowner's policy or seek additional insurance from an agent if you desire more than our standard coverage.**

Shipping costs to and from the show, including insurance during shipping, are the responsibility of the entrant. Instructions will be included in the Jury Acceptance Letter.

Quilts for Sale: A 10% handling fee collected from sales. A sale price must be indicated, further negotiations permissible.

Three Rivers Quilt Show is a juried and judged annual exhibition of quilts sponsored by Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. to promote the art of quilt making. Additional information regarding entry rules, prizes and awards available on website.
