* **Stationary Quilting Machine** - Machine which allows the quilter to move the fabric rather than the machine. Machine is positioned on a table.

* **Moveable Quilting Machine** - Machine that allows the quilter to move the machine head rather than the fabric and is mounted on a frame.

General Rules

1. Limit of three (3) quilts per entrant. **If entering more than 1 quilt, indicate your priority for consideration: 1, 2, or 3. Priority will be considered when the total number of qualified entries for the show is excessive and must be limited. All entries accepted will be judged.**
2. All entries must be quilted. A quilted entry consists of three (3) layers, primarily fabric, held together by stitching. Quilting stitches pierce all three (3) layers and are distributed throughout the entry. **EXCEPT for those placed in the Potpourri category (if offered). No tied quilts will be accepted. NO WEIGHTS OR FRAMING OF ANY KIND SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE QUILT. Quilts with electrical components are not accepted.**
3. All entries must have been completed within the last five (5) years. Please do not submit entries completed before January 1, 2019.
4. All entries must be clean, smoke free, labeled, and ready to hang. Detailed instructions will be included in the jury acceptance letter.
5. No items entered and shown in previous Three Rivers Quilt Shows should be submitted.

Category	Size – perimeter (total combined measurement of all sides) (ALL Categories – Max. width 96")	Description (Any number of makers except in Solo categories)
Theme	Any size.	Quilt reflects show theme "Flying Geese". (All techniques, any number of makers.) Definition: Flying Geese are rectangular patchwork quilting components that are twice as long as they are tall, each with a peaked triangle at its center. Small triangles flank opposite ends of the peak.
Appliqué*	Any size.	Appliqué is predominant technique (90%)
Modern	Any Size	Functional rather than decorative design, asymmetric design, increased negative space, improvisational piecing, modern art/architectural inspired design, simplistic and/or minimalist.
Pieced Small - Solo	<300"	Piecing is predominant technique - made for bed, lap quilt, baby quilt
Pieced Small	<300"	Piecing is predominant technique - made for bed, lap quilt, baby quilt
Pieced Large – Solo	>300"	Piecing is predominant technique (90%). (Made for a bed)
Pieced Large	>300"	Piecing is predominant technique (90%). (Made for a bed)
Wall Hanging	Any Size	Pieced or Applique – made to hang on the wall
Art	Any Size	Any art form that uses traditional and non-traditional quilting techniques to create fiber art objects (such as pictures, paintings and landscapes) usually to be hung on a wall.
Kits/Block of the Month (Pieced quilts)**	Any Size	Any pieced quilt made from a kit or Block of the Month pattern where the fabrics have been pre-selected by a quilt shop or designer and used in your quilt (even if some provided fabrics were substituted). Includes patterns with pre-selected/pre-fused fabrics.
Mixed Technique	Any Size	Balanced combination of both appliqué and piecing; including embroidery & other needlework techniques in any combination.
Potpourri	Any Size	Crazy Quilt, Yo-Yo, Wool, Cathedral Windows or Wholecloth (no tied quilts will be accepted) Use this category if your quilt does not seem to fit in any other category.

****This category reserved exclusively for "Pieced" Kits/BOM construction, any size. Other categories may include Kits/BOM (Applique, Art, Mixed Tech, Potpourri). Please indicate on 1st page any quilt that was made from a Kits/BOM using the fabric provided. Additional details in the Quilt Show Entry Rules.**

Each entrant must submit: Please check to make sure your entry includes ALL of the following.

- One **completed**, signed entry form for each entry.
- (2) color 4" x 6" photos (non-returnable) for each entry (**Full** front view & **Close-up** of front stitching). Nothing larger than 4x6 please!
- **ENTRY FEE: \$13.00 for 1st entry, \$10 each additional entry (ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETE WITH PHOTOS).**
- Members of Three Rivers Quilters, Inc. get their first entry for a \$1 handling fee, \$10 for each additional entry. (\$1 for each photo that has to be printed by the guild.)
- Make checks out to "Three Rivers Quilters, Inc." (No cash, *exception for TRQ members' \$1 entry & photo charges*).

Shipping costs to and from the show, including insurance during shipping, are the responsibility of the entrant. Instructions will be included in the Jury Acceptance Letter.

Quilts for Sale: A 10% handling fee collected from sales. A sale price must be indicated, further negotiations permissible.
